When my mother first started saying that she hated me, no matter how often I heard the words, I refused to believe it was true. My young, optimistic mind was simply unable to process something so painful. Then, one morning, when I was around eight-years-old, Mama called me to take a bath. As she filled the tub, steam rose from the water and hung heavy in the room, and I stood by naked, shuddering in fear, uncertain of what was about to happen. Suddenly she turned to me, her face contorted by the hate I denied, and in an instant, I felt her grip tighten at the back of my neck as she forced me headfirst into the scalding water and smashed my face into the bottom of the bathtub. It was then that the terror of drowning, of being killed by the person I loved most, finally grabbed me by the shoulders and shook the truth into me.

There are many people today who are in the same denial as I was then. Cruelty to a child, particularly by a parent, is unimaginable and just plain wrong, and for these reasons our minds have a hard time accepting it

as fact. That's why stories like *Call Me Tuesday* are important. As difficult as it may be to believe, the abuse I endured as a child--the abuse described in the book--is 100% true. Only the names, locations and some insignificant identifying details were fictionalized, something I decided to do out of respect for the innocents involved and to spare my family unnecessary embarrassment and shame. *Call Me Tuesday* is my small attempt to make as many people as possible aware that extreme maltreatment of a child at the hands of a parent does actually happen, an ugly truth I feel everyone needs to know.

Leigh Byrne is an American author whose books include two Amazon bestselling memoirs, the brutal *Call Me Tuesday*, in which she reveals her experiences as a victim of severe child abuse, and *Call Me Cockroach*, which continues her story, explaining how her childhood trauma controlled and crippled most of her adult life and how she struggled daily to overcome the repercussions of her past.
